Extracts relating to bread, ale and aletasters

Leet and court held on Monday, morrow of the feast of St. Denis, 11 Edward II [1317]

- The wife of Reginald Cavel has brewed and sold her beer, contrary to the assize and is amerced 6d.
- Reginald Cavell has baked and sold [bread] contrary to the assize and is amerced 12d.

Leet of the Bishop of Carlisle held at Melreth on Sat. after St. Andrew's day, 13 Edward II [1319]

- Nicholas Faber of Everesdene paid 18d fine for infringement of the assize of ale by default in the office of ale-taster. Surety - John le May.
- John de Genting bread brewed contrary to the assize. 3d.
- Similarly, William Chastayn. 3d.
- Similarly, the wife of Ralph Reaper. 3d.
- William Chastayn and Geoffrey Pompe amerced 3d for not acting as tasters.

Court and view of Frankpledge of the Bishop of Carlisle, held on Thursday, after St. Faith's day, 10 Edward II [1316]

- Reginald Cavel amerced 12d for brewing contrary to the assize.
- William Chastein amerced 6d for the same.
- John Helbe 6d for the same. William Sponge 6d for the same.
- John, son of Michel, 6d for the same.
- Reginald Cavel has baked contrary to the assize. Amerced 6d.
- Tasters - Geoffrey Pompe 3d, William Chastein 3d.

Court Leet of the Bp. of Carlisle held at Melreth on Monday, next after the Trans. Of St. Edward, 12 Edward II [1318]

- Amabilia, wife of Wm. Chastein baked brewed and sold contrary to the assize. Amerced 3d. Surety-Geoffrey Pumpe.
- Alice, daughter of John de Gentting, amerced 3d for the same. Surety, John de Gennting. - 12 - Similarly, Joan, wife of Reginald Cavel, amerced 6d. Surety- Reg. Cavel.
- Reginald Cavel has baked contrary to the assize. Amerced 6d. Surety - the bailiff.
- William Chastein refused the office of taster. Surety - Hugh Cagewyne. Pardoned.

Court held on the Friday after Michaelmas, 14 Edward II [1320]

- Margery, wife of Nich. Le Fenvere, did not bring her measures. Distress made. 20d paid for default.
- The wife of Wm. Chasteyn amerced 3d for brewing contrary to the assize; similarly, the wife of John Gentyng, 3d., and the wife of Ralph le Hayward, 3d.
- Geoffrey Pompe and Wm. Chasteyn, aletasters, amerced 3d each for not performing their office.

Court and View held Thursday after St. Denis 16 Edward II [1322]

- The wife of Hugh Cagwyne (6d), the wife of John le Rous (6d) amerced for brewing contrary to the assize.
- William Chasteyn amerced 6d for not performing the office of aletaster

Court and view of Frankpledge held on Tuesday after St. Faith, 18 Edward II [1324]

- The wife of John Friday was amerced 3d for brewing and selling contrary to the assize. Similarly, Margaret de Kenting (3d), the wife of Hugh Cagwyne (6d).
- Hugh Cagwyne was amerced 6d for not performing the office of beer—taster

View of Frankpledge held on Thursday, Feast of the Trans. of St. Etheldreda 19 Edward II [1326]

- The jurors of Eversdon present that Joan, late the wife of Robert le May, baked and sold contrary to the assize. Amerced 3d.

Court held Thursday, after Michaelmas, 1 Edward (III) [1327]

- The wife of Hugh Cagwyne Hugh Cagwine brewed and sold contrary to the assize. 6d.
- The same Hugh did not perform the office of aletaster. Pardoned.

Eversdon:

- Alex. Cristemasse de Eversdon was chosen aletaster in Eversdon.

Court held on Saturday after Trans. of St Thomas the Martyr ,3 Edw. III [1329]

- Nicholas Faber brewed and sold contrary to the assize. 3d.
- The same Nicholas did not perform the office of aletaster. 3d.
- Hugh Chagwyn', 6d, John Friday, 3d, Margaret Hankyn 6d have brewed and sold contrary to the assize.
- Richard Chagwyn baked and sold contrary to the assize. 3d. The said brewers, for not bringing their measures into court, 3d.

- Geoffrey Pumpe, Hugh Chagwyn have not performed the office of ale—taster. 12d.

Leet of John de Brumtonn held Monday, feast of SS Simon & Jude, 5 Edward III [1331]

- Margery, wife of Nicholas Croume brewed and sold contrary to the assize. 6d.
- Geoffrey Pompe amerced 3d for not performing the office of aletaster.

View and Leet of John de Brompton held on Tuesday after the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, 6 Edward III [1332]

- Richard Cagwyn baked and sold contrary to the assize. 6d Castanna, wife of Hugh Cagwyn', brewed and sold contrary to the assize. Amerced 6d. Margery, wife of Hugh Cromme, brewed and sold contrary to the assize. 12d Hugh Cagwyn', Geoffrey Pompe amerced for not performing the office of aletaster
- Agnes, wife of Hugh butcher, brewed and sold against the assize. 12d. Alex. Miller failed to perform the office of aletaster. 3d

View and Leet of John de Brumpton held on Monday before Michaelmas, 7 Edward III [1333]

- William Hulcok brewed and sold contrary to the assize. 6d.
- Nich. Crumme the same, 6d.
- John Sponge the same, 3d.
- Hugh Cagwyne the same 3d.
- Geoffrey Pumpe amerced 3d for not performing the office of aletaster.
- Hugh Caggewyne for the same, 3d.
- Richard Cagwyne baked contrary to the assize, 12d.

Eversdon :

- The said Hugh (le Fleshewer) brewed and sold contrary to the assize. 3d.
- Alex. Miller did not perform the office of aletaster. 2d

View and Court of John de Brumpton' held on Thursday after Sy Thursday after St. Denis, 8 Edw. III [1334]

- Ric. Caggewyne brewed baked and sold contrary to the assize. 6d
- Hugh Caggewyn' brewed and sold contrary to the assize. 6d.
- John Friday, Wm. Hulcok, John Songe Sponge, 6d each for the same.
- Hugh Caggewyne (3d) Geoffrey Pumpe (3d).
- W. Hulcok, have not performed the office of ale tester.

Eversdon:

- Agnes, wife of Hugh le Becher, for brewing contrary to the assize. 6d.
- Alex. Miller, for not performing the office of aletaster. 3d.

View and Court of John de Brumpton held on Thursday before Michaelmas, 9 Edward III [1335]

- Ric. Cagwyne baked and brewed contrary to the assize. 6d. Hugh Cagwyne (6d), Wm. Hulcok (6d) and John Sponge (5 6d) brewed contrary to the assize.
- Hugh Cagwyne (3d) and Wm. Hulcok (3d) have not performed the office of aletaster.

Eversdon:

- The same Hugh (Bocher) Brewed and sold contrary to the assize. 6d. Alex. Miller was amerced 3d for not performing the office of aletaster

View and Court of John de Burneton held on Monday after Nativity B.V.M. 10 Edward III [1336]

- Richard Cagewyne the baker baked and sold contrary to the assize. 6d. The wife of the said Richard Caggewyne (6d), the wife of Hugh Caggewyne (6d), the wife of William Hulcok (6d) and Amice Le Carter brewed and sold contrary to the assize. William Hulcok, 3d, and Hugh Caggewyne 3d, have not performed the office of aletaster.

Eversdon:

- The wife of the said Hugh (le Bocher) brewed and sold contrary to the assize. 3d.

Court with Leet of John D John de Brompton held on Monday after All Holy Souls Day, 11 Edward III [1337]

- Ric. Cagwyn baked and sold contrary to the assize. 6d. Castane, wife of Hugh Cagwyne, brewed etc. 6d. Julian, wife of Wm. Hulcok, brewed etc. 6d. Amice le Carter brewed etc. 6d. Hugh Cagwyn and William Hulcok did not perform the office of aletaster and were amerced 3d each.

Eversdon:

- Agnes, wife of Hugh le Bocher de Eversdon brewed and sold contrary to the assize, 3d.
- Agnes, wife of the said Hugh, sold ale by two gallons and quart measure (per mensuram et potellam et quartale and not by the gallon (lagenam). 3d.

View and Court of John de Brumpton held on Thursday after All Saints 12 Edward III [1338]

- Joan, late the wife of Richard Cagwyne, baked contrary to the assize. Hugh Cagwyne and William Hulcok were amerced 3d each for not performing the office of aletaster.

Eversdon:

- The wife of Hugh Bocher brewed contrary to the assize. 3d. Alex. Miller did not perform the office of aletaster. 3d.

Court with Leet held on Monday after St. Matthew, 13 Edward III [1339]

- William Hulcok, 6d, the wife of Hugh Cagwyne 6d, the wife of John Gentyng, 3d, were amerced for brewing and selling contrary to the assize. Hugh Cagwyne, 3d, and William Hulcok, 3d, were amerced for not performing the office of aletaster.

Eversdon:

- Agnes, wife of Hugh le Bocher, was amerced 3d for brewing contrary to the assize. Alexander Miller has not performed the office of aletaster. 2d.

Court and View held on Thursday after St. Luke, 15 Edward (III) [1341]

- The wife of Ralph le Hayward, 6d, the wife of John le Fevere, 3d, the wife of John le Rous, 6d, and the wife of John Gentyng, 8d, brewed and sold contrary to the assize.

Court held with view of frankpledge held on Monday, St. Faith's Day, 28 Edward III

(Note – I assume that this date is most probably an error and should read 18 Edward III, in which case it is 1344)

- The wife of John B Trumpton' brewed and sold contrary to the assize. 3d.
- William Hulkok did not perform the office of aletaster. 2d

Eversdon:

- Alex. Milnere, the head of the pledge, and all owing suit present that Joan, wife of John Dalowe (?) brewed and sold contrary to the assize. 12d.
- Alex. Milnere did not perform the office of aletaster. 3d.

Court held on Thursday after Ss. Fabian and Sebastian, 19 Edw. III [1345]

- John Dalowe brewed and sold contrary to the assize. 6d.
- Alex. le Mellere did not perform the office of aletaster. 6d

- John Trumpyton brewed and sold contrary to the assize, 6d.
- William Hulkot did not perform the office of aletaster, 3d.

Leet with Court Held on Thursday after All Saints, 30 Edward III [1356]

- John Trumpiton brewed and sold contrary to the assize. 6d.
- Wm. Hulcok did not perform the office of aletaster. 3d.
- Hugh Fryday was elected aletaster.

Leet with Court held on Monday, Feast of St. Edmund the King, (31?) Edward III [1357]

- Joan Calowe brewed contrary to the assize, 2d. She did not bring her measures.

View and Court of George de Borenton held on Thursday after the feast of St. Denis, 32 Edward III [1358]

- John Dalawe, 3d, brewed and sold contrary to the Assize.
- John Mayfey was elected aletaster.
- John Dalawe, 2d, for not having his measures at this view.
- The wife of Robert Marion, 6d, and the wife of John de Trumpyton, 8d, brewed and sold contrary to the assize. Hugh Friday did not perform the office of aletaster. 6d.

View and Court of Alice de Brompton, sister and heir of George de B., held on Thursday after the feast of the Conception B.V.M. 35 Edw. III [1361]

- John de Brompynton brewed and sold contrary to the assize. 6d.
- Hugh Friday did not perform the office of aletaster. 3d

Everesdon:

- John de Yhillyng defaulted, 3d, John Dalow the same 6d. brewed and sold contrary to the assize, 6d.
- John Mayfay did not perform the office of aletaster, 3d.

Court with View of Frankpledge of Laurence de Pabenham held on Monday, feast of St. Denis, 36 Edward III [1362]

- The wife of John Trumpington brewed and sold contrary to the assize, 6d.
- Hugh Friday failed to perform the office of aletaster, 3d.

View and Court held on Thursday, next (after) the feast of Michaelmas 40 Edward III [1366]

- John Trumpyngton, 12d, and the wife of Wm. Cotele, 6d, brewed and sold contrary, to the assize.
- John Trumpyngton did not perform the office of aletaster. 3d.

Court with view of Laurence de Papenham held on Tuesday after the feast of St. Nicholas, 41 Edward III [1367]

- The wife of John Trompyngton, l2d, the wife of Wm. Smyth, 3d, brewed and sold contrary to the assize.
- John Trompyngton did not perform the office of ale tester.
